

Krishnapatnam Port Sets An All India Urea Discharge Record

As everyone is settling in after the festivities of the New Year, Krishnapatnam Port has another reason to celebrate its huge success of setting an all India record of discharging 35,278 tons of urea in just 24 hrs. using the conventional system of fertilizer unloading for ports in India.

The Vessel M.V. Trident Protector carrying 56,930 tons called at Krishnapatnam Port on a/c of M/s. IFFCO on January 6, 2011. The record discharge was completed on January 7, 2011.

This feat surpassed Krishnapatnam Port's previous record of 20,373 tons which was established barely a few days earlier on December 28th 2010.

This achievement is the first ever in the history of any port in India & possibly in the world. The entire trade community is over-whelmed with it. The receivers of the cargo has expressed their joy to be a part of this record and has appreciated the port management, staff, workers and others who helped in achieving this marvelous feat.
